

Japanese

The children will learn about the Japanese culture and Japanese Language. The children will:

- Think and talk about special feelings for Father's Day and learn about Japanese culture through the Star Festival, 'Tanabata'
- Use varieties of materials and tools to enjoy art and craft about the topic
- Building vocabulary by enjoying new songs and new stories
- Enjoy playing group games together by following the rules

Expression

The children will engage in a variety of art, drama and music activities related to space.

Activities include:

- Use a range of materials creatively
- Develop understanding of colour
- Uses imagination to represent ideas.

Language

- Phonics -We will continue to try using our phonic sounds independently when reading and writing.
- Independent Writing- speech bubbles, beginning, middle and end of stories, comics, and captions. Beginning to use exclamation marks.
- Oral language development - using role play to develop speaking in full sentences
- Reading - guided reading and story time
- Handwriting - forming lower-case letters correctly

Health

The children will participate in physical activities such as:

- Learning to participate in simple games
- Practicing ball skills such as kicking, passing.

Environment

- Freezing and melting
- Flight
- Senses - smell, taste, touch, sight, hearing

- Counting forward and backward to 50
- Drawing simple 2D shapes

- Ordinal language (1st, 2nd, 3rd...)
