COVID-19 TREATMENT REPORT

< Standard Time School Attendance Prohibited for COVID-19 >
"Student attendance is prohibited for 5 days counting from Day 1 and one day has passed after symptoms have recovered*. Day 0 is when symptoms first appear or an asymptomatic student takes a test."

*Recovery of symptoms means that your child reduces their fever without using fever-reducing medicines and symptoms of respiratory conditions improve, etc.
