

Environment

During Environment time in K1 the children will:

- Play friendship circle games
- Talk about our surroundings and school campus
- Talk about people who help us
- Talk about people who are important in their lives
- Learn about their place in the world

Expression

During Expression time in K1 the children will:

- Singing songs related to their learning
- Enjoy drawing, paintings and creating.
- Use natural resources creatively
- Make a Father's Day gift
- Use a variety of materials.

Language

During language time in K1 the children will:

- Sing circle time songs
- Name and identify feelings
- Name and identify classroom items
- Use appropriate social language with their friends and adults in class
- Name common vehicles, food and animals
- Recognise people who help us.
- Pre-writing activities to build their hand muscles (playdoh, building, cutting, coloring etc)

Math

During Math's time in K1 the children will:

- Sing maths songs
- Explore 2D shapes
- Children are encouraged to use their own way to record quantities (fingers, marks, dots, picture etc).
- Through daily discussions, begin to understand and follow a class visual timetable. Use some number names and number language during play
- Children explore numbers to 5 and matching number to quantity.



Everything Around Us

Health

During Health time in K1 the children will:

- Recognize basic feelings in themselves and their peers.
- Talk about how to stay healthy.
- Understand what the different parts of the body are for.

Human Relationships

During Human Relationships time in K1 the children will:

- Continue to play alongside other children happily
- Work with other children and teachers within kindergarten
- Become aware that some actions and words can hurt others' feelings
- Think about what it means to be a 'good friend'

Japanese

During Japanese time in K1 the children will:

- Talk about people, places and things around us by singing Japanese songs and reading picture books
- Enjoy participating Japanese traditional events, such as Father's Day and Tanabata
