Japanese

The children will learn about the Japanese culture and Japanese Language. The children will:

- Learn about Japanese traditions and cultures through the events such as Mochitsuki (Mochi Pounding), Setsubun (Bean Throwing) and Hinamatsuri (Doll Festival)
- Be aware of finishing the Kindergarten program and celebrate their graduation by preparing for Graduation ceremony
- Develop their confidence and responsibilities by reviewing class rules and manners and looking forward to becoming G1 students.

Expression

The Children will engage in a variety of art, drama and music activities related transportation. Activities include:

- Creating 3D sculptures using a variety of materials
- Painting inspired by famous artwork
- Singing songs related to transport and travel around the world.

Language

- Phonics -encouraged to use their knowledge of phonics independently in their writing and reading
- Writing Focusing on extending length of writing and using varied and interesting sentences
- Oral language development detailed spoken answers, descriptions, and explanations
- Reading Answering more complex questions about what they have read
- Handwriting practicing capital- and lower-case letter formation correctly
