

Japanese

During Japanese time in K1 the children will learn about the Japanese culture and Japanese language.

They will:

- Learn greetings and routine in the classroom
- Enjoy singing Japanese songs and stories related to the topic 'All About Me'
- Enjoy participating Japanese traditional events, such as Children's Day and Mothers' Day.

Expression

During Expression time in K1 the children will:

- Enjoy joining in with dancing and circle games
- Sing a few familiar songs
- Begin to move rhythmically
- Imitate movement in response to music
- Explore colour and shape.

Language

During language time in K1 the children will:

- Sing circle time songs
- Name and identify feelings
- Name and identify classroom items
- Use appropriate social language with their friends and adults in class
- Name and identify body parts
- Name family members and friends
- Pre-writing activities to build their hand muscles (playdoh, building, cutting, coloring, threading, painting).

Math

During Math's time in K1 the children will:

- Sing circle time number songs
- Children are given opportunities to look for shapes in their environment
- Through daily discussions, begin to understand and follow a class visual timetable.
- Use some number names and number language during play.

Health

During Health time in K1 the children will:

- Move freely with pleasure and confidence slithering, shuffling, rolling, crawling, walking, running, jumping, skipping, sliding and hopping
- Learn snack and lunch time routines, including going to the toilet and washing hands.

Human Relationships

During Human Relationships time in K1 the children will:

- Settle into their new classroom.
- Learn to play alongside other children happily
- Select resources to play with in the K1 classroom
- Form relationships with K1 teachers and friends
- Begin to take turns and share resources with friends
- Learn simple kindergarten routines.

Environment

During Environment time in K1 the children will:

- Learn about their new friends and teachers
- Learn about their new classroom and school
- Share stories and information about their friends and families
- Play friendship circle games.
